Recipes from Famous Locations on Route 66

Sites Station Café

A little diner in a converted railroad car that sat next to a Site gas station. It was located between Eureka and Allenton on Highway 66 east of Long Ford. All the locals added an "s" to the name. The diner was known for this chili that simmered all day on the stove and had a sobering-up effect.

Sites Station Café Chili

2 lbs ground beef

1 large onion, diced

2 tsp garlic powder

2 Tbsp chili powder

Add salt & pepper to taste

1 6oz can tomato paste w/ 2 cans water

1 #10 (foodservice size) can red chili beans plus 1/2 can water

In a large cast iron Dutch oven, brown ground beef with 1 large onion. Sprinkle in dry ingredients. Add tomato paste and water. Mash one half of the red beans and keep the other half unmashed. Add all to pot. Fill the large can halfway with water and add to pot. Let chili simmer all day.
